

Modernizing Legacy Equipment

- Permitting – no longer just a handshake with landowner
 - Typically digital stations require larger footprint
- Telemetry
 - Long distance radio links and phone lines
 - Limited success so far with digital VHF radios (haven't tested 25kHz bandwidth yet)
 - Primarily using 900MHz ISM radios and cellular
- Improved data quality (latency instead of noise)
- Someone always has their favorite station
- “Upgrade” just means we are using the same location, usually requires all new infrastructure
