Flight Follow Up Rule - always make POC

Assess conditions on site (Stop work policy)

Oil/Gas industry - EHS all injury is preventable (mentality)

- post analysis of event

- implementation of corrective action

Best practices are JSA (job safety management)

All stuff on most common are mostly preventable (maybe not carrot)
